





# OUR TOURS



The tour begins in the porch ①, which dates from the 14th century, and includes the Nave, North Aisle, St John's Chapel, Chancel, Lady Chapel, and South Aisle.

<b>A</b>	45-75 minute Guided Tour only	£3 per person
<b>B</b>	75 minute Guided Tour with tea, coffee and cake on arrival	£6 per person
<b>C</b>	75 minute Guided Tour with tea, coffee and cake on arrival and buffet lunch; wines and soft drinks may be purchased	£16 per person
<b>D</b>	75 minute Guided Tour with tea, coffee and cake on arrival and 2-course lunch; wines and soft drinks may be purchased	£20 per person
